Blinds: 10x20, 6 dogs per blind in Instinct, Novice and Open, 4 dogs per blind for Senior and Master

B DIVISIONS: If you have titled in Master you have to enter Master B. If you enter any B division, you must stay in that division for the entire event. For more descriptions of B divisions please see the rulebook.

Entry Limits:

Judges are limited to 8 hours of judging and a maximum run value, which will require this Club to limit entries accordingly

DIRECTIONS TO ALAMEDA EAST VETERINARY HOSPITAL: Go east on I-70 to Exit 287 (Quebec St toward CO 35/Northfield). Keep right, follow signs for Johnson & Wales University & merge onto Quebec St. Turn left on Alameda Ave & Alameda East Veterinary Hospital will be on the right.

Collars and Leads- IMPORTANT

Approved collars include flat snap or buckle collars of solid construction and leather or nylon leads. Slip martingale collars are allowed. Single piece slip collars/leads are allowed. Harnesses, with the exception of head-halter types, are allowed. Dogs **MUST** run "naked," without a collar/harness. **NO** flexi-leads allowed.

Bitches in season

Bitches in season (BIS) MAY compete at Barn Hunt trial. They will be run at the end of each class. **Bitches in season must wear pants**

Height divisions are to equalize efforts for dogs of the same general size.

Small: Dogs 15" and under

Medium: Dogs 15.1 to 22"

Large: Dogs over 22"

Awards

Each division and height group will have awards through fourth place based on the elapsed time of marking the rat tube. Title rosettes will be awarded to dogs finishing a title. Fastest Dog in each division will receive a special prize and rosette. B divisions are placed with all heights combined except for Master which will have awards by height.
